

**CAD hastily builds up accounting wisdom by encouraging accounting voluntary teachers to pass knowledge about occupational cost accounting to better farmers' living according to sufficiency Economy Philosophy.**

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Mr. Singthong Chinnawornrungrsee, Director-General of the Cooperative Auditing Department (CAD) reveals that to alleviate poverty and develop countryside, according to the government policy, as well as to upgrade Thai people's quality of life to be sustainably happy, CAD has an urgent urge to promote teaching accounting system to Thai agriculturalists with the goal that accounting voluntary teacher as CAD's representatives fulfilled with accounting skills introduce accounting to communities.

Consequently, CAD organized a seminar project focusing on accounting voluntary teachers. Its topic was "Occupational Cost Accounting to household Business Planning" aiming at building knowledge about income-expense household accounting and occupational cost accounting preparation provided to instructors as advisors, evaluators and collectors of data entering from networked private farmer. This seminar gave an opportunity to exchange ideas among coaches concerning problems and obstacles in operation leading to further relevant support by CAD.

1,400 volunteers from 76 provinces were selected by CAD to participate in seminars held in Cooperative Auditing Offices Regions 1-10. The project, launched on 26 March, 2011 at Phanom River View, Muang District, Nakhon Phanom Province, was presided over by Mr. Supacahi Phosu, Deputy Minister of Agriculture and cooperatives, participated by 400 accounting voluntary teachers in Cooperative Auditing Office Region 5 Area comprising Udon Thani, Loei, Sakon Nakhon, Nong Khai, Nong Bua Lam Phu, Khon Kaen and Nakhon Phanom.
